



How to Transfer Downloaded Files to SD/MMC Care: **DiscountCombo1.usr**

Now that you have “saved” the BOATLANES information to your computer by following the instructions on your download page you need to **UNZIP** and then transfer the file to a blank SD/MMC card. **Most newer computers now have SD card slots built right into them, but if you have an older computer without this then you can purchase a “card-reader” that plugs into your computer via the USB port and it will work the same.**

- a) Start by inserting the blank memory card into the slot on your computer. You will most likely see a window pop up on you computer that gives you choices about how you want to open the newly connected storage...You want to **“open and view files”** in the memory card.

How to Unzip Compressed Files:

On Windows XP and earlier: When you double click on the “zipped” file (*downloaded and saved to your computer*) you will see a window pop up that says: **“WINZIP WIZARD”** ...Follow the steps in the wizard to successfully unzip the file. Includes clicking **“Next”** to begin the **Wizard**; Select the option to **“EXTRACT ALL FILES;”** Choose location for the Extracted (unzipped) files—If it is already on your computer’s desktop then that will be listed as the destination by Default—Click **“OK”** and unzipped files should appear on desktop: (*without the zipper icon on the front*)—Still named **DiscountCombo1.usr** Double click the unzipped folder icon to reveal the **seven files** inside: **Fork.usr Samrayboth.usr Samraytrls.usr Samraywps.usr Tblendboth.usr Tblendtrls.usr Tblendwpts.usr** Next is step b)

On Windows Vista: When you click the zipped file a pop-up window will appear with the option at the top to **“Extract All Files.”** Click **“Extract All Files”** and another window asks you to “Select a Destination” for and “Extract All” files. If “Desktop” is where you originally saved the zipped file then by default the extracted file will also be placed on the computer desktop. With location selected...Click **“EXTRACT”** at the bottom. Now a window will appear that shows files: **Fork.usr Samrayboth.usr Samraytrls.usr Samraywps.usr Tblendboth.usr Tblendtrls.usr Tblendwpts.usr** “UnZipped.” (*To verify status: When a file is “zipped” it has a folder icon with the picture of a zipper up the front/When “unzipped” the file icon is a sheet of paper with the top right corner folded down.*)

- b) Hover your mouse pointer over the **Fork.usr** file icon and **“right-click”** to reveal a drop-down menu. Scroll down the list and highlight **“SEND TO.”** Then another drop-down menu will be revealed. Scroll down that list until you find the option that describes the SD/MMC card you have inserted into your computer and **“left click”** on that. A copy of the file should be sent now to the memory card. **You will know this has been done because as you have the memory card window open you will now see a copy of the BOATLANES information appear inside.**

You should see **“Fork.usr”** inside the memory card. Repeat beginning with **Step b) for Samrayboth.usr and Tblendboth.usr**

- c) Next, safely eject the memory card from your computer or card-reader.
- d) Insert the memory card with the BOATLANES data into your GPS card slot and follow the appropriate **BOATLANES Installation Instructions** (*You can also find a copy on our website www.boatlanes.com)*

***NOTE:** Please be sure to **“Unzip”** before you copy to your SD/MMC card because if you try to insert a **“zipped”** file into your gps unit...It will not recognize the information and you will have to return to your computer to complete this step.
